General Information

- Venue: Delta Sports Complex (If pitch is unavailable, games will be played at CCAB)
- The league will commence in February 2014 and end by June 2014. The games will be played on weekends and the fixtures will be out shortly upon confirmation of all teams.
- There is no limit to the number of players a team can register but each team must register a minimum of 9 players.
- We are limiting the participation to 14 teams only. As such, all teams will play each other once, followed by the placing game.



- With 14 teams, each team gets a total of 14 games.
- There is no age and foreign restriction in this league.
- Official umpires will umpire the games.

Fees per Team

• \$800 per team

Tournament Format

- Match time: 25 minutes x 2 halves, 5 minutes half time break
- This is a one-way league + placing games. Each team plays each other once and all teams will play the placing game based on the league standings.
- League stage: Win = 3 points, Draw = 1 point, Lose = 0 point



- As each team can register any number of players, it is important to note that any one player SHALL NOT play for more than one team.
- International Hockey Federation rules will be adopted.
- If a team is not present to play their game, the game will be forfeited with a 3-0 win to the present team.
- As it is a 9-a-side game, a team can start the game with a minimum of 6 players.
- In case of clash of colors, the Home Team (first named team on the fixture schedule) will have to change their jerseys.
- SHIN GUARDS are mandatory for all players taking part in this league.
- In case of inclement weather, we will act in accordance with Sports Council guidance.



- Any team which withdraws during the Tournament will be liable to pay a penalty of a fine up to \$100/- per team and face other disciplinary action as the Tournament Committee may deem fit. This rule will also apply to teams giving walkovers during the Tournament.
- Disputes, appeals or complaints should be lodged within 15 minutes of the match concerned by the Team Manager or Captain to the Tournament Director. Each dispute, appeal or complaint must be in writing accompanied with a fee of \$100/and in the absence of the payment, the dispute, appeal or complaint shall not be entertained. Depending as the case may be, of the nature of dispute/appeal/complaint, the Tournament Director will arrange to convene a meeting with the Tournament Committee to deliberate on the case. Failure in the appeal or complaint may cause the fee to be forfeited. The Tournament Committee's decision on such matter shall be final.
- By playing in the competition, all players and officials acknowledge that they shall abide and be bound by the said Rules. Players or officials who do not adhere to the rules and regulations will not be allowed to play in the tournament
